DISCUSS AND DETERMINE PROJECT PRIORITIES FOR THE ALACHUA COUNTY TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM SURTAX.

Mr. Popoli presented a list of streets that need to be paved or repaired along with his recommendations of priorities. Mr. Popoli's recommendations are as follows:

SW 1st Street from SW Railroad Avenue to CR 340 - Repave
NW 174th Avenue from US 27 to NW 222nd Street – Resurface
NW Railroad Avenue from NW 202nd Street to NW 222nd Street - Pave
SE 4th Street from SE 1st Street to the end – Pave with cul-de-sac
NW 4th Avenue & 7th Street intersection – Drainage and repave
NW Railroad Avenue from NW 1st Street to NW 13th Street – Pave
NW 222nd Street from NW 174th Avenue to NW 154th Place – Pave
NW 154th Place from NW 222nd Street to NW 214th Terrace – Pave
NW 214th Terrace from NW 154th Place to NW 142nd Avenue – Pave
NW 158th Avenue from US 27 to the Railroad tracks – Pave

Mr. Popoli explained the final version with the cost estimates needed to be submitted to the county by Tuesday, March 13, 2012.

Vice Mayor Barnas suggested Railroad Avenue, NW 222nd Street (Tillman Rd), NW 158th Avenue and Boat Ramp Road.

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Mayor Davis suggested the dirt street off NE 1st Avenue, (NE 6th Street) by Jim Douglas.

Commissioner Weller suggested NW 174th Avenue, NW 222nd Street (Tillman Rd), Boat Ramp Road and Railroad Avenue; as well as, looking at the ones that are in the core that are dirt.

Mrs. Langman gives the list NW 222nd Street (Tillman Road), NW 158th Ave. (Sewer Road), 174th Ave., Boat Ramp Road, Railroad Ave (past Memorial Field area) and NE 6th Street.

Motion Commissioner Weller the six roads identified in the meeting along with another four selected by the city planner to be submitted to the county commission for the transportation surtax. Second Vice Mayor Barnas. Motion carried 4-0.

Motion Commissioner Weller to adjourn the meeting. Second Vice Mayor Barnas. Motion carries.
