The High Springs Police Department is now recruiting for our new Law Enforcement Explorer Program.

Law Enforcement Exploring also known as Police Explorers is a Career-Oriented program that gives Young Adults the opportunity to explore a career in law enforcement by working with local Law Enforcement Agencies. Founded on July 12, 1973, it is one of the Exploring Programs from Learning for Life, a Non-Scouting subsidiary of the Boy Scouts of America.

Requirements for the High Springs Law Enforcement Explorer Program are:  
Must be 14, and graduated from the 8th grade;  
Have a 2.5 (C+) Grad Point Average;  
No older than 20 years old.

The program Nationwide is generally available to qualified Young Adults who graduated 8th grade and are ages 14 through 21.

Law Enforcement Explorers participate in various activities and training. They also are afforded the chance to attend public events, conferences, competitions, be involved in community service, as well as ride along with Officers on patrol.
