High Springs Man Arrested for Uttering a Forged/Counterfeit Bill

July 27, 2015 – High Springs Police Department (HSPD) arrested Kevin Darrod BRADSHAW, 27, of 23448 NW 179th Place, High Springs, for one Felony count of Uttering Forged/Counterfeit Bill.

On July 9, 2015, at approximately 10:55 AM, BRADSHAW entered Cheers Liquors, located at 115 NW Santa Fe Boulevard and uttered a forged/counterfeit twenty dollar bill to purchase goods from the business. BRADSHAW'S transaction was captured on video surveillance and he was positively identified by the clerk.

Investigation revealed that in 2014, BRADSHAW had been involved in several other counterfeit cases in Gainesville, Alachua, and High Springs. The investigation is still on-going, and other law enforcement agencies in Alachua County are expected to file additional charges on BRADSHAW.
